The Amount

The **2019** award was given in the following categories (a total of \$5,000):

- Dental Assisting Program
 - Two Recipients will be chosen for a \$500 award to be dispersed to each
- Dental Hygiene Program
 - One 3rd year student will be chosen for \$1,000 award
 - One 4th year student will be chosen for \$1,000 award
- Dental Laboratory Technology Program
 - One 1st year student will be chosen for \$1,000 award
 - One 2nd year student will be chosen for \$1,000 award

**The amount may vary and will be determined by the Foundation Board on an annual basis.*

Requirements for the Award

Applicants must be currently enrolled in one of the Dental Education Programs (Dental Assisting, Dental Hygiene, Dental Laboratory Technology) at Indiana University Fort Wayne.

The online application form also requests information about the student including:

- Current GPA when applying
- Confidential employment and financial information
- Personal Statement: Applicants will be asked to discuss the qualities and characteristics the Selection Committee should consider, i.e., life and career goals, academic interests, etc., when reviewing their application.

Selection of Recipient

A Scholarship Committee, appointed by the Foundation president, chooses the annual recipient.

Award Presentation and Distribution of Scholarship

- The award is paid directly to the school and credited to the student's account, unless other arrangements are necessary
