

How Can I Help Isaac Knapp?

The Isaac Knapp Dental Education

Foundation has distributed more than \$500,000 to various children's oral health and community outreach initiatives, free clinics, student scholarships, and continuing education programs. **This is all made possible from generous donations from our members.** Here are a couple of easy ways for you to contribute to this great foundation.

1. **Gift appreciated securities.**

If you have investments (stocks, funds, ETFs) that have appreciated in value, then gifting them to IKDEF will help your tax situation and the foundation. If you invested \$10,000 into fund XYZ and it is appreciated to \$20,000, you have unrealized gains of \$10,000. If you sell fund XYZ, then you would owe capital gains taxes on the \$10,000... let's call it \$2,500. Instead of selling shares of fund XYZ, if you gave the position to IKDEF you would not pay any capital gains tax and potentially get a deduction for a charitable contribution provided that you've held the position for at least one year. This is a major win-win!

2. **Incorporate Isaac Knapp into your Estate Plan.**

Another way to help our foundation is to leave money to IKDEF when you pass away. This can get a little tricky, so it is important that it is done properly. Here are two easy ways to accomplish this.

- **Add the Isaac Knapp Dental Education Foundation as a beneficiary to an IRA.** You can leave a certain percentage to IKDEF and the remainder to your other beneficiaries. If you have an IRA that you feel is too large, you can usually establish a separate IRA with a particular amount to

accomplish this goal. The other benefit to this is that you can continue to receive income from the account during your lifetime.

- **Add the Isaac Knapp Dental Education Foundation as a beneficiary in your Last Will.**

You can leave a specific dollar amount to IKDEF and the remainder to your other beneficiaries. If this approach is taken, it will be important to review the titling of your assets to determine which assets will move via beneficiary designation and which assets will move via the Last Will. Our office is happy to review this for you to make sure it will work.

3. **Qualified Charitable Distributions.**

This is possibly the biggest tax benefit for seniors that are charitably inclined. Once you reach age 70 1/2 then you are permitted to make gifts from your IRA directly to a charitable organization without including them in your income. These gifts also count towards required minimum distributions.

- 4. **Practice Transitions.** A practice transition can be one of the biggest tax burdens you will have in your life. One particular idea that you could consider for the transition year is to contribute to a Donor-Advised Fund (DAF). A DAF is an account specifically funded for future charitable giving. Some of the benefits to the strategy are that you receive a tax deduction the year in which the account is funded, you maintain control of the gift amounts and recipients, and the money can be invested. There are no requirements to make gifts from the account annually and there are no special tax filings to maintain the account. It is a very easy process to fund and distribute this type of account.

Contributing to the Isaac Knapp Dental Education will help so many people in need in our community and will truly change people's lives. If done properly, it can be a tax benefit for you and your estate. Please contact Jamee or our office if you have any questions on how to proceed.

Dr. John Regan was recently recognized as the 2022 IKDDS Component Honor Dentist. He will also be recognized at the Midwest Dental Assembly in May.

The following is a portion of the introduction that Dr. Steve Regan gave to recognize Dr. John Regan as IKDDS Component Honor Dentist during the Past Presidents and Future Leaders Event.

IKDDS HONOR DENTIST, DR. JOHN REGAN....BY DR. STEVE REGAN

If there is one thing about my father that I've understood during my lifetime more clearly than anything else is that when he takes on a project, he does so with every ounce of energy, focus, and determination to do the best job that could possibly be done. Whether it is a simple writing assignment, putting up Christmas lights that only Clark Griswold would be proud of, or even having children (which I am one of eight. Who does that?), this energy was also heavily focused towards leadership in our profession and throughout our community.

A FEW WAYS MY DAD IMPACTED THE PROFESSION OF DENTISTRY

He practiced as a solo dentist in Huntington for 61 years. We could stop right there, but there's plenty more. In 1969, he was appointed by the Governor of Indiana to serve on the five member Indiana State Board Dental Examiners. I later found out that we all have dad to at least partially thank for having the perio session on our state board exam. True story!

In 1975, he assisted and founded the Indiana chapter of the Academy of General Dentistry. Later that year, he became the national director of the AGD and in 1980, he was elected as president of the AGD on the national level.

In 1981, he was recognized as the Indiana AGD Dentist of the year and in '82, he was inducted as a fellow into the American College of Dentists. In 1990, he was awarded the AGD Distinguished Service Award.

He was also instrumental in starting programs such as Family Day at the Dentist, Dentists with a Heart, and the local Isaac Knapp Science Fair Program.

He's belonged to numerous other dental service organizations, including the Council of National Board of Dental Examiners, the National Foundation of Dentistry for the Handicapped, and the American Fund for Dental Health.

During his career, he's offered numerous research papers that have been published in the Journal of ADA, Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry, and the Journal of IDA.

COMMUNITY IMPACT OF DR. JOHN REGAN

His passion for leadership did not stop with organized dentistry, he was involved with many local charities as well. In 1964, he

served on the board of directors for the Huntington County United Way and later served as its chapter president in 1968.

In 1965, we became the founding president of the Huntington County Pathfinder Services, an organization that focuses on helping individuals with disabilities to integrate into society. Its an organization still going strong today.

In 1969, he was awarded the Huntington Jaycees Distinguished Service Award and recognition as one of five outstanding young men in Indiana.

In 1984, he became the founding president of the Huntington Chapter of the American Cancer Society.

He's been a lifelong supporter of the Boys Scouts of America. In 1978, he served as the Tomahawk District Chairman. In 1990, he was awarded the prestigious Boys Scouts Silver Beaver Award for continued, life-long community service.

A LIFE-LONG LEARNER

His passion for continued learning about dentistry was on a whole other level. In 1992, he received his MAGD recognition, an achievement that requires 1,100 hours of CE.

In 2014, he received the Lifelong Learning and Service recognition from the AGD, which requires 1,000 hours of CE after obtaining your MAGD. At that time, only 304 dentists nationally had ever received such recognition.

My father estimates that he receives an

average of 100 hours of CE per year, over his 61 years of practicing.
